

The Real Hate in the Debate

Rosanna Pulido is the founder and director of the Illinois Minutemen, a branch of the Minutemen Project. She is also the Regional Field Coordinator for the Federation for American Immigration Reform (**FAIR**), a group listed as **hate group** by the Southern Poverty Law Center.
