

HEALTH BENEFITS FOR IMMIGRANT ADULTS (HBIA)

- As of June 30th, HBIA, the life-saving healthcare coverage program for immigrants, is closed.
- If you were enrolled in the HBIA and turned 65 years old before July 1, 2025, you should have been transitioned to HBIS (Healthcare Benefits for Seniors). If you were not automatically transitioned, please contact our FSN hotline at 1-855-435-7693.
- HBIS enrollees: It's very important that you still submit your renewal for coverage. You will receive your redetermination notice via mail. For questions, call HFS 1-877-805-5312 from 7:45am – 4:30pm.
