- As of June 30<sup>th</sup>, HBIA, the life-saving healthcare coverage program for immigrants, is closed.
- If you were enrolled in the HBIA and <u>turned 65</u> <u>years old before July 1, 2025, you should have been transitioned to HBIS</u> (Healthcare Benefits for Seniors). If you were not automatically transitioned, please contact our FSN hotline at 1-855-435-7693.
- HBIS enrollees: It's very important that you still submit your renewal for coverage. You will receive your redetermination notice via mail. For questions, call HFS 1-877-805-5312 from 7:45am – 4:30pm.
