- **LAGING** tandaan: May karapatan ka na manatiling tahimik
♦ Maaring gamitin laban sa iyo ang anumang sasabihin mo
- **May karapatan kang sabihin na**, "Ayaw kong makipag-usap sa iyo o sagutin ang mga tanong mo."
- **LAGING** iulat ang pagtatagpo sa Family Support Hotline ng ICIRR

Kung maaaring arestuhin ka ng ICE sa palagay mo:

- **May karapatan kang tanungin na** "Inaaresto mo ba ako?" at "Malaya na ba akong umalis?"
- **LAGING** sabihin sa kanila na gusto mong manatiling tahimik at gustong makipag-usap sa isang abugado

Ano ang HINDI DAPAT GAWIN kapag makatagpo ng ICE

- **HINDI** mo kinakailangan na **BUKSAN ANG PINTUAN NG TAHANAN MO** KUNG WALANG WARRANT NA NILAGDAAN NG HUKOM
- **HINDI** mo kailangang **LUMAGDA** ng anumang dokumento na hindi mo naiintindihan
- **HUWAG TUMAKBO**
- **HINDI** mo kailangang magsabi ng anumang maliban sa kagustuhan mo na manatiling tahimik

Kard ng mga Karapatan

- Kung arestuhin mo ako, patuloy kong gagamitin ang karapatan ko na manatiling tahimik at tumanggi na sumagot sa mga tanong mo.
- Gusto kong makipag-usap sa isang abugado bago ko sagutin ang mga tanong mo.
- Hindi ko pinahihintulutan ang iyong pagpasok o pagsisiyasat.
- Hindi ko lalagdaan ang anumang dokumento na hindi ko maintindihan
- Gusto kong makipag-ugnayan sa abugado o organisasyon na ito:

Know Your Rights:

What to do in case of an ICE encounter:

- **DO** remain calm,
- **DO** remember: You have the right to remain silent.
♦ Anything you say can be used against you
- **You have the right to say**, "I do not wish to speak with you or answer your questions."
- **DO** report the encounter to ICIRR's Family Support Hotline

If you suspect you might be arrested by ICE:

- **You have the right to ask** "Am I under arrest?" and "Am I free to go?"
- **DO** tell them you want to remain silent and want to speak to a lawyer

What NOT TO DO in case of an ICE encounter:

- **You are NOT required to OPEN THE DOOR TO YOUR HOME** WITHOUT A WARRANT SIGNED BY A JUDGE
- **You are NOT required to SIGN** any document
- **DO NOT LIE.** Don't give explanations, excuses or stories
- **DO NOT RUN**
- **You are NOT required to say anything** except that you wish to remain silent

- I want to speak with a lawyer before answering your questions.
- I do not consent to your entry or search.
- I will not sign any document I do not understand.
